ONE YEAR LATER...

It's the middle of March 2021 and a sense of normalcy is finally returning to Animal Friends. With some of the COVID restrictions being lifted, the shelter was able to open its doors to the public again at the beginning of the year. Previously, doors were locked and appointments were necessary to gain entrance for emergency owner surrenders, cruelty cases, and strays. AFHS staff and several volunteer programs had to be reduced early on. Although it was a struggle, the shelter team found new ways to care for and protect the animals in their care, while at the same time keeping the staff and community safe.

The initial response to the pandemic was to get as many animals as possible out of the shelter and into foster or adoptive homes. The action from caring people throughout the area was immediate and heartwarming. Sixty-three animals were placed in the first ten days (24 cats and 39 dogs). Also, 12 cats and 29 dogs were adopted into loving homes! Adoptions never slowed down as the pandemic continued, and by the end of 2020 the shelter had placed 1,198 dogs and 1,767 cats into new homes.



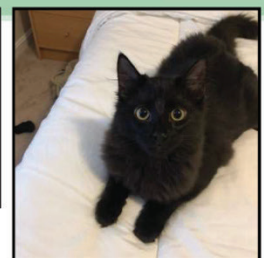
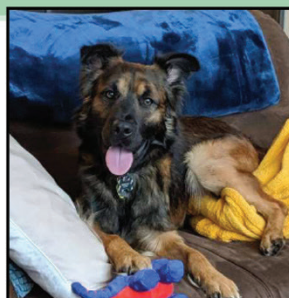

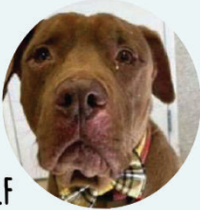

Interview with the #1 Butler County Dog, Elsa!

ELSA has lived with the Homshers for five of her 11 years. Adrielle found her on Facebook. It was apparent the former owner had been using her for breeding and was no longer interested in her as a pet. The woman's vague answers to questions left Adrielle wondering about Elsa's sad past. When taken to a veterinarian, it was evident that Elsa had had multiple litters and had breast cancer. Immediate and continued care was given and finally the large lumps disappeared. After healing, Elsa was finally spayed.

DAILY LIFE: Elsa practically glues herself to Adrielle all day and at night. She loves riding in a car and goes with Adrielle to work at a local veterinarian's office. There she burrows under a blanket at Adrielle's feet when her mom is acting as a receptionist, and sleeps when Adrielle is assisting the vet during surgery. Back home she is a cuddly lap dog giving and receiving kisses. She will also cuddle up with visiting strangers and falls asleep in their laps. Such a sweet personality! She's loving, loyal and happy! At night she takes her medicine at bedtime and gets a treat. (Her favorite is Greenies, a dental chew.) And, just like glue, she sleeps next to Adrielle's face or on her head. "She must be touching 24/7."

FAVORITE TOYS: Pink seems to be Elsa's favorite color. She favors the pink blanket that she was wrapped in when brought home from the "back yard breeder." She loves and prefers her well-loved stuffed pink elephant toy that was her first gift. Even her crate is pink! She often wears a pink shirt to keep her warm. It has PRINCESS written on it. She also sports a pretty pink collar with a bone-shaped name tag, plus her new #1 DOG tag. Yes, she is a little princess pup and deserves to be called the #1 Dog in Butler County.

TRICKS: Elsa is very smart and knows what is being said. She knows "sit," "treat," "bed," "medicine," "work," "bye bye," and much more. She listens and is responsive to everything spoken.

BATHS: Elsa loves baths and enjoys her's with Adrielle in the shower. "She gets excited and is well-behaved even while being drenched with water."

SIBLINGS: Elsa's fur-family includes two other Min Pins: a red 7 year-old "Molly," and a black 1 1/2 year-old "Cola." (Adrielle says she wants more Min Pins.) Recently added are two tiny kittens---a 6 month-old "Blaze" from a super large litter, and another, "Brad Kitt," a one-eyed rescue that is also 6 months old. "Brad was only 3 months old and had only one eyeball when rescued by Adrielle. Another furry playmate is "Lola," Zack's parents' 12 year-old dog that had been adopted from Animal Friends when it was located in Trenton.

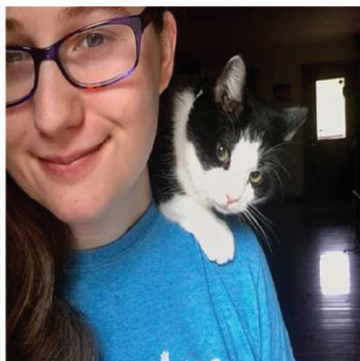
DECEMBER 2020

Animal Friends is proud of its diverse programs that help meet the needs of its community and the animals that are brought to them in need. Animal care is top priority and animals are treated as the individuals that they are, with each of their needs met to the best of the shelter's ability. Of course, the final goal is adoption and the shelter's devoted volunteers play huge roles in helping make that happen. In 2019, the shelter had 722 volunteers log a total of 18,551 hours. With COVID disrupting their volunteer program, the shelter only saw 605 volunteers in 2020 logging a total of 13,055 hours.



Although volunteer numbers are slowly increasing as more people feel safe to get out, there's still a critical need for more volunteers to help aide the shelter staff and devoted volunteers who show up day in and day out. According to Tara Bowser, Executive Director, "We are on our way back to normal and are looking for a variety of volunteers to help us achieve our lifesaving mission." Bowser explains that they desperately need dedicated dog walkers. "We have a core group of volunteer dog walkers who put in full-time hours to ensure each dog at the shelter gets 3 walks and play yard time every single day, but they're exhausted and feeling the strain of not having enough help. Even if you can only commit to one

day a week, or a few hours here and there, anything is better than nothing and helps to ease that burden."

Dog walking isn't the only volunteer opportunity at Animal Friends. Individuals are needed in each department to help with a variety of tasks. If cats are more appealing than dogs you can volunteer in Cat Adoption to offer some out-of-cage time and enrichment to the cats waiting to find their forever homes. Cleaning and laundry help is always needed to assist the kennel staff in getting the shelter in tip-top shape before it opens to the public each day. Interested in learning more about the medical aspects of



animal welfare? Surgery volunteers get to learn from the medical team while they're assisting with tasks like sterilizing surgical instruments, taking animals back to their cages after recovering from surgery, and cleaning the cages in the surgery holding rooms. If you're more of a people person, you can train with the front office staff to help them assist customers who come in looking to adopt, or are possibly trying to find their lost pet who may be waiting at the shelter to be reclaimed. Spring through fall is the perfect time to get out and volunteer with the shelter's Petmobile crew, who go out each weekend to showcase adoptable pets throughout Butler County and beyond!



Volunteers are the heart and soul of Animal Friends. Their "pay" is the warm and fuzzy feelings of knowing they have provided help to animals that need their love when they are brought to the shelter when lost, abandoned, or in need of medical attention.
